The Broadcast Engineer position is responsible for the efficient and effective day-to-day maintenance and operations of the underlying broadcast and TV production technological infrastructure and for elements of IT technology that supports the activities of the studios. Due to the nature of the business, work hours may include nights and weekends. This position reports to the Director of Broadcast Technology.

- Technical Support- Perform installation, configuration, troubleshooting, technical support and repair of broadcast technologies, television production and IT equipment across multiple functional areas. Act as a subject matter expert and first point of escalation for production and transmission. Participate in department's efforts to investigate service anomalies or hardware malfunctions.
- Streaming support – Monitoring and troubleshooting video streams for web, social and other OTT platforms.
- Maintenance – Participate and contribute to a preventive maintenance program and schedule in order to provide NGE with an efficient and reliable technical infrastructure.
- Business Continuity – Work with management to help plan future needs, and studio builds.

Emergency- Availability to participate, respond to and manage 24x7 responses to emergency facility needs.
